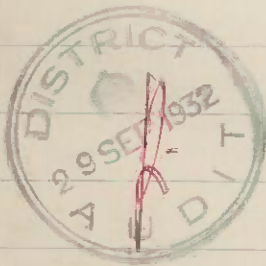

was concluded the meeting.

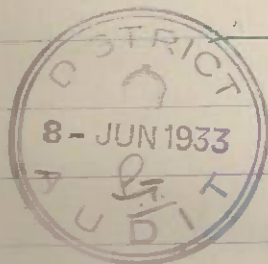
meeting held Feb 25th 1933

& after discussion it was decided to offer
it at 1/6 per sq. yd. subject to the
approval of the Minister of Health.

The thought it would be no use
refusing as the Council needed it for
Road widening purposes. & seeing the two
cottages were down for demolition. They
thought perhaps some good may
come out of it. seeing the Council are
helping cottages of that description.

It was decided to cover ditch at Bottom
of village with sanitary pipes & Mr A
Taylor was asked to do the work.

Annual Meeting held April 22nd 1935

The minutes of the last meeting were read
& approved & carried unanimously.

Chairman Mr A. Ford was duly elected
Chairman for ensuing year pro Mr Lund
& seconded Mr Wily & carried.

The housey committee were elected as
follows Mr Cartwright Taylor Lund
Wily & the Chairman.

The chairman said he had received
a cheque for land sold for
road widening by the housey Council
to the value of £6. 19. 6. which
was considered very good & the money
would be spent in repairs to
property.

The chairman explained that the two cottages owned by them had been before the Public Health Committee of the Rural District Council & after some discussion it was decided to receive the demolition order as the Parish Meeting had given an undertaking to repair in accordance with the Sanitary Officer & the Medical Officer of Health specifications.

So it was decided to ask for tenders for work to be carried out.

It was also stated that the ditch at the entrance to football had been covered in by Mr. A. Taylor for the sum of £1.0.0. The meeting thought was very cheap seeing the nature of the work.

This concluded the meeting.

Meeting held June 24th 1935

This meety was called to discuss the repairs to properly the estimates that was asked for. was very difficult to obtain as the men would not give estimates as they were all houses & difficult to estimate for. So only one was received that of Mr. E. Norton in the sum of approximately \$55. \$30 for one & \$25 for other one.

The meety was greatly surprised at the very low figure as the roof was to be raised & new daisy rough eavly all round. new shanty & various other repairs.

So it decided to accept his bid which was unanimously accepted.

Meeting Held Oct 7th 1938⁵

The minutes of the last meeting were read
& confirmed.

The accounts were submitted as passed
by the District Auditor

Previous to this meeting the housing
committee had inspected the ward
house & found the roof about badly
in & it was decided to ask Mr.
Norton to put it in good repair

The fresh estimates for the whole
lot would be round about £70
which was accepted & the rents increased
by 6^d per week each cottage.

The Chairman was instructed to pay Mr Norton
what money he could afford leaving a bit in
hand for any repairs that might arise.

1936.

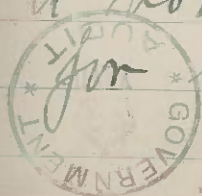
Present: Messrs Taylor Cartwright Ward

Annual Meeting Held April 26 1937

cottages to the Rural District Council
& it was decided to hold rents
until we got a decent sum to
give back say £10. we must cut our
expenses down to pay back as soon
as possible.

The retiring Chairman pointed out that
he felt he could not devote the
time but the meeting asked him to
carry on for another year as he was

most acquiescent with the work
so he did so. very reluctantly.

The representatives appointed on the
Rating Authority were Mr & Mrs
& Mr W C Cartwright.

The representative on the Ammott's
Parish Hall was Mr & Mrs

The Chairman having received an
Application for one of the Colleges
from some Old People it was
unanimously decided to give
them three months resolution
in accordance with the
agreements.

The Chairman asked for confirmation
of his action in presence of
the District Council for 1880

which was mentioned at a Premier
meeting that was given unanously
A Motion vote of thanks to
the Chairman for all the trouble
he has had with the Property
was unanously passed.

Meeting Held April 25th 1938

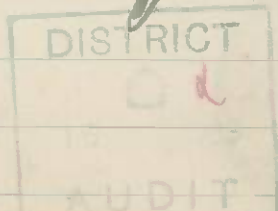
The minutes of the last Annual meeting were read + confirmed.

The accounts as submitted to the Auditor were presented + it was agreed that owing to the cottages being repaired extensively the Balance was considered very good.

The chairman was asked to carry on another year.

The representatives on the Rating Authority were reelected.

It was decided to delay any repairs to cottages for the present owing to the unrest in the country. This ended the meeting.



Annual Meeting Held March 25th 1940

The minutes of the last meeting were read & confirmed.

The accounts as passed by the Auditor were presented and were considered very satisfactory.

Mr. A. Ford was re-elected chairman for another term.

The housing committee were re-elected as also were the representatives on the rating committee.

The cottages were again discussed for repairs & it was decided to see what building materials were available before doing anything. It was decided to have another meeting later in the year.



Meeting Held Dec 16th 1940.

There was a good attendance at this meeting.

The minutes of the last meeting were read & confirmed.

Cottages repairs

It was decided to repair cottages & the housing committee were asked to view the same to see what necessary repairs want doing.

The committee comprised me & I said me & E. Barwright & Mr J Wiley.

The question of an Air Raid Shelter was discussed & after careful consideration it was decided not to apply for one as the village was not suitable.

Now the question of Fire fighting was discussed. This was pointed out even more urgent as we have had fire bombs dropped in the vicinity.

It was agreed to purchase 3 Strapp Pumps if the Government could not allow 3 to purchase them out of the village funds provided the District Auditor was agreeable to that course.

Three fire teams were appointed to man the pumps.

It was further decided to ask for a length of hose & appliances for dealing with a larger fire.

It was also pointed out that the 3 wardens were not fully equipped the chairman was asked to write to the person responsible.

The question of Telephone was discussed & it was pointed out that only one private phone was in use in the village. The chairman was instructed to write the Postal Authorities with a view to getting a kiosk installed also an authorized place to sell postage stamps.
